For those of you who do not know Scott, he was a vibrant 28-year-old young man & cherished son. He was a respected and admired teacher/coach in the city school system. On October 31, 2004, a reckless drunk driver took Scott's life. The driver of the car had two prior DWI convictions, no license, and yet still chose to drive while intoxicated. In order to keep Scott's dream alive, we are raising money for Foundation. Our goal for this event is to help the foundation purchase new coats for their "Warm Project" and new books for their Literacy Program.
